

NHC Commissioners Meeting – November 20, 2017

Joint resolution with New Hanover County Board of Education to notify Newland Communities a school is needed in River Lights was unanimously approved by the Board.

The regular meeting of the NHC Board of Commissioner was held at the Court House from 9:00 a.m to 9:50 a.m. All commissioners were present.

Judge Corpening gave the annual update on the New Hanover County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council. This program is very effective and high praise was given to Judge Corpening and his work by all members of the Board of Commissioners.

Annual report was given by the County ABC Board. Sales were up and more tax revenue was received by New Hanover County. NHC ABC was the second most profitable of all of the counties in the state.

Cape Fear Museum gave their annual update. The museum has new exhibits and has established more programs for seniors and school children. One of the newer exhibits focuses on 1898 in Wilmington.
